

I recommend approval of this purchase to Chattanooga Golf Carts, 1915 Broad Street, Chattanooga, TN 37408, as the best bids meeting specifications for the City of Chattanooga. The apparent low bidder Sol Invictus's payment terms conflicted with the City's standard terms, The Lilly Company's payment terms conflicted with the City's standard payment terms and did not satisfactorily meet the Departments pricing specifications, and BSN Sports equivalent proposed did not satisfactorily meet the Departments specifications.
