It was necessary to make an emergency purchase of a new roof for the Frances B. Wyatt YFD Center due to the failure of the existing roof and the attempts made over the past several months to repair the many roof leaks. The facility is scheduled to have renovation work done to the gym floor and this work was not possible given the rapidly failing condition of the roof. Records on the exact age of the roof are unclear but given that limited roof repairs were included in the plans of the Center renovation in 1993, this would seem to indicate that the roof is the original roof for the building that was constructed in 1976 and thus approximately 40 years old.

Without this emergency purchase, the periodic closure of the facility following significant rain events would certainly continue and the planned renovation work would not have been possible. The purchase order for this equipment was issued to JDH Company in the amount of \$62,125. This was a sole source bid.

In my option, this emergency repair was justified and the City's best interest was served by the decision.
